HOW TO ARRIVE

LOCATION:  BUILDING A - UNITS

BY CAR: Exit from the A4 highway (Turin-Trieste) at highway exit “Lisert”. Continue for about 15 kilometers. After the Prosecco tunnel turn right and follow indications for Trieste Opicina. After few kilometers, turn right at traffic light and then downhill towards the city center (about 6 kilometers to reach the university campus of Piazzale Europa 1).

BY TRAIN: The reference station is “Venezia-Mestre” to which the city is connected by several daily runs. Duration of the route: about 2h.

BY PLANE: Trieste airport is located in Ronchi dei Legionari (GO), connected to Trieste through a public transport service, both bus and train.

BY BUS FROM CITY: The university campus in Piazzale Europa 1 can be reached from the city centre with bus lines: 3, 4, 17, 17/, 39, 51. 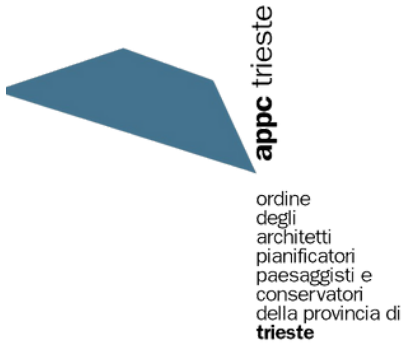
